Inactions/failure of the respondents to take necessary steps to remove earth filling/ construction/ encroachment/ structure/ dam constructed within the territory of Dhansiri River situated at Rajapur Upazila, District- Jhalakathi, violating the provisions of law.

AND

IN THE MATTER OF:

For a direction upon the respondents to protect the Dhansiri River situated Rajapur Upazila, District- Jhalakathi to its original territory as per C.S./R.S. records.

## G R O U N D S

I. For that the duty and responsibility vested upon the respondents to serve the people and initiate lawful steps and they are also duty bound to obey the provisions of law. But the respondents have failed to perform the duties and responsibility as vested upon them against any violation of the provisions of law by way of earth filling, building permanent structures within the area of Dhansiri River situated Rajapur Upazila, District- Jhalakathi, which is illegal. Hence direction may be given upon the respondents to remove earth filling, dam, illegal encroachment and structures within the territory of the Dhansiri River.

II. For that disregard to laws and legal provisions and failure to ensure proper implementation of laws, the respondents have caused damage to the environment; to the River and to the local people as well as the right to life of the people. Under these circumstances the respondents are legally bound to protect the River in accordance with law at one hand and to remove the earth filling/ structures/ dams/ encroachment as made within the River.

III. For that under Section 5 of the মহানগরী, বিভাগীয় শহর ও জেলা শহরের পৌর এলাকাসহ দেশের সকল পৌর এলাকার খেলার মাঠ উন্মুক্ত স্থান, উদ্যান এবং প্রাকৃতিক জলাধার সংরক্ষন আইন, ২০০০, also prohibits change of the nature of any land that

has been earmarked as a natural reservoir. As per section 8 of the Act 2000 any person who acts in contravention of the Act is liable to imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or a fine not exceeding Taka 50,000 or both. Hence, a direction may be given to remove the earth filling, dam, structures, encroachments from the territory of the River.

IV. For that encroachment, earth filling and making permanent structures in the territory of the Dhansiri River is contrary to all applicable laws of the country. That the encroachment of river and permanent structures in the territory of river has created obstruction to the normal movement of the said river.

V. For that the environment is being continuously endangered and threatened by various illegal activities such as encroachment, earth filling and making illegal permanent structures in the territory of Dhansiri River. The unauthorized activities are the main causes for environmental degradation. Taking advantage of the silence of the concern authority, the illegal activities is being continued and as a result the environment is being destroyed.

VI. For that the non-implementation of the laws by the respondents undermine rule of law and jeopardize people's fundamental right as guaranteed under Article 32 of the Constitution of Bangladesh.

Wherefore, it is most humbly prayed that your Lordships would graciously be pleased to:-

a) Issue a Rule Nisi calling upon the Respondents to show cause as to why failure/inaction of the respondents to remove all kinds of earth filling, encroachment, dam, permanent/ temporary constructed structures within the Dhansiri River situated Rajapur Upazila, District- Jhalakathi, should not be declared illegal and without lawful authority.

AND

Why a direction should not be given upon the respondents to demolish/evict all earth filling/ structures/constructions/dam built within the territory of Dhansiri River situated Rajapur Upazila, District- Jhalakathi and to protect the said River as per record to its original position and why a direction should not be given upon the respondents to dredge/dig to its original width and

periphery of river Dhansiri situated at Rajapur Upazila, District- Jhalakathi.

b) Pending hearing of the rule direct the respondents to ensure no further earth filling/ dam/ constructions/ structures/ encroachment within the territory of Dhansiri River situated Rajapur Upazila, District- Jhalakathi and submit a compliance report by the respondent nos. 7-12 before this court through affidavit within 2 (two) weeks.

c) Pending hearing of the rule direct the Respondent no. 6 and 11 to conduct a survey of the area of Dhansiri River situated Rajapur Upazila, District- Jhalakathi as per C.S./R.S. record and submit the report along with list of encroachers and encroach land within 30 days before this court through affidavit.

d) Direct the respondent no. 7 to investigate the matter who are liable for giving the order of dredging/ digging of the area of Dhansiri River in a short width form to its original width and direct the respondents nos. 2, 5 and 7 to take legal action against those who gave the order of dredging/ digging of the area of Dhansiri River in a short width form to its original width under the provision of law.

**Present Status:**

The case was filled and moved by Advocate Manzill Murshid, President, HRPB. After hearing the parties the Hon'ble Court issued Rule Nisi upon the respondents and granted ad-interim order. The matter is pending before the Hon'ble High Court Division.
